1. Strauss Esmay Alert 217 Con't
These policies are a result of the Student Safety Data System (SSDS) replacing the Electronic Violence and Vandalism (EVVRS) reporting mechanisms. It's a simple name change within the policy. All are mandatory.

 - b. Regulation 2460.8 - Special Education - Free and Appropriate Public Education
 - c. Regulation 5530 - Substance Abuse
 - d. Policy and Regulation 5600 - Student Discipline/Code of Conduct
*Update to include exclusion from activities based on discipline.
 - e. Policy and Regulation 5611 - Removal of Students for Firearms Offenses
 - f. Policy and Regulation 5612 - Assaults on District Board of Education Members or Employees
 - g. Policy and Regulation 5613 - Removal of for Assaults with Weapons Offenses
 - h. Policy and Regulation 8461 - Reporting Violence, Vandalism, Harassment, Intimidation, Bullying, Alcohol, and Other Drug Offenses
