- Will be placed in the Book Room to be used by teachers in their classrooms.

- 4. Chromebook Update 6<sup>th</sup> grade
  - Positive roll out of the Chromebooks as well as feedback from the teachers.

  - The system has been very reliable and quick loading
  - Teachers enjoy the 1 to 1 of the devices and are learning to add chromebooks to their daily vocabulary. (pencils, paper and chromebooks)
  - 400 devices are actively on, 8 have had to go through troubleshooting most were basic issues and 1 device had a larger issue.
