#### **Minutes**

#### 1. Curriculum Revisions

- a. Social Studies Grades 1 and 2: A link to the accommodations and modifications list currently posted on the website was placed in the assessment section, and key skills were added to the pacing guide. Interdisciplinary connections and 21st Century Skills are new sections and contain information not previously contained in this document. The materials sections were reorganized with the labels of core materials and supplemental materials. Lessons regarding the contributions of African Americans and Holocaust education were added and/or more clearly labeled. There were also revisions in the assessment portion where the assessments have been reorganized, relabeled, and benchmarks added.
- b. Social Studies Grades 5 and 8: A link to the accommodations and modifications list currently posted on the website was placed in the assessment section, and key skills were added to the pacing guide. Interdisciplinary connections and 21st Century Skills are new sections and contain information not previously contained in this document. The materials sections were reorganized with the labels of core materials and supplemental materials. There are also revisions in the assessment portion where the assessments have been reorganized, relabeled, and benchmarks added. Lessons focused on Holocaust/Genocide education were updated and clearly labeled. Lessons regarding the contributions of African Americans were more clearly labeled in 5th grade, and lessons regarding slavery, the slave trade, and vestiges of slavery were updated in 8th grade
- c. Chinese Grades 6 and 7, French Grades 6-8: The world language curricula have a condensed purpose and overview section. In addition, a link to the accommodations and modifications list currently posted on the website was placed in the assessment section, and key skills were added to the pacing guide. Interdisciplinary connections and 21st Century Skills are new sections and contain information not previously contained in this document. The materials sections were reorganized with the labels of core materials and supplemental materials. There are also revisions in the assessment portion where the assessments have been reorganized and relabeled.
- d. Theater 6-8 and Dance: The theater and dance curricula have key skills added to their pacing guides and a link to the accommodations and modifications list posted on the district website was

- placed in the assessment section. The assessment section for each unit was revised to include formative, summative, benchmark, and alternative assessments. Interdisciplinary Connections with corresponding activities, 21st Century Skills with corresponding activities, and core materials were added at each grade level.
- e. ELA K and 1: A link to the accommodations and modifications list currently posted on the website was placed in the assessment section, and key skills were added to the pacing guide. Interdisciplinary connections and 21st Century Skills are new sections and contain information not previously contained in this document. The materials sections were reorganized with the labels of core materials and supplemental materials. There are also revisions in the assessment portion where the assessments have been reorganized and relabeled. Units of Study for Phonics information and pacing were added to the reading units.
- f. Math Grade 1, 3, 3 Honors, 4, 5: Assessments broken out, Advanced Math removed from 4th grade curriculum
- g. Health and Physical Education K-8: The Health and PE curriculum has been updated with 21st Century Skills and Interdisciplinary Connections.

- i. Science Grades 6-8: New 2021 standards to include climate change
