## II. New business

- a) Readington News Article
  - Original schedule called for an article about the Solar Project but the committee felt there was insufficient information currently to compose an article. It was determined that the article would cover Use of School Property by Community Agencies. Dr. Sargent will draft and submit.
- b) Class Size Policy Review
  - The committee has reviewed class size policies and recommended changes to the class sizes at HBS. There was also a recommendation to remove decimal "students" from the designated class sizes in RMS. Dr. Sargent will revise the policy and submit for review.

New recommended language for Class Size for 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> grades is:

Maximim – 22 students (down from 25)

Minimum - 18 students (down from 22.3)

Target - 21 students (down from 23.7)

Removal of decimal at guidelines for 6<sup>th</sup> through 8<sup>th</sup> grades is 23 (adjusted from 23.4 students)
