COVID Activity Report

This week our region has seen a return to orange in the COVID Activity level. This means our region maintains high levels of COVID activity as opposed to very high levels. This change in designation is a good sign that things are improving.

Updated: Quarantine Guidelines for Close Contact

Individuals in the following groups do not need to quarantine. Please notice the first bullet which has been updated by the Department of Health.

- Adults and children 12 years or older who completed a primary series of the COVID-19 vaccine and have received all recommended vaccine doses, including boosters (only if six months from the primary series).
- Children and adolescents ages 5-11 who completed the primary series of COVID-19 vaccines. There are no recommendations for booster doses for this age group.
- Persons who had a confirmed case of COVID-19 within the past 90 days.

This past week we welcomed sports and extracurricular activities back. These programs were up and running with great success. We look forward to the coming weeks and months as we hope the COVID situation continues to improve.
