- Dr. Hart presented an update on the progress, action steps and accomplishments on the 2024-2025 district goals through April. The goals include three strategic goals of inquisitive learning, social awareness and partnerships, along with academic achievement, communications enhancement and referendum planning. Other noteworthy projects shared were Sustainable Jersey for Schools Recertification process, governance and policy work, a successful budget cycle given constraints, and final steps in retention and recruitment efforts.
