- 1. Middle School Math Update (Carey-Anne Hendershot and Sarah Pauch)
 - a. Majority of coach's time has been spent on Technology
 - b. i-Ready is now being used at RMS, previously only K-5 (i-Ready is an online program that assesses students, identifies areas of strength as well as areas that need improvement, and provides personalized instruction on targeted skills.)
 - i. Used in classrooms, at home reinforcement, and during academic support
 - ii. First diagnostic shows 50% of students are at or above grade-level
 - c. Algebra II students move onto to IXL (not enough available on i-Ready)
- 2. Math iReady Diagnostic
 - a. Overall, we showed improvement over last year, even with interrupted instruction
 - b. Pacing guide and mid-year assessments will be used to guide us if we need to make changes to our plan to ensure students are prepared for the next grade level (for both math and language arts)
- 3. Guidance has been provided that Snow Days can now be virtual learning days. Discussion is ongoing as to whether we will change the school calendar
- 4. Strategic Plan one page document
 - a. Working with I&D and Art teacher at RMS to have kids design a new logo
- 5. Special Education Updates
 - a. Bringing more special education students back. Nov 30th a group of students returned for in-person instruction prioritizing students with behavior plans and one-on-one paras..
 - b. Enrichment programs for learning loss are being explored
